- 02. BCP has four branches (Astley-Dale, Ladybridge, Little Lever, and Market Surgery).
- 03. You can still visit your original practice and see your preferred doctor or nurse.
- Waters Meeting Health Centre is open late every night of the week and on Saturday mornings.
- 05. All sites have wheelchair access bar Market Surgery.
- 06. You can attend different sites at different times.
- 07. You only need to remember one number 01204 463444.
- You can request a new patient form from any branch OR by calling the central number.
- 09. New patients are offered a Health Check with the practice nurse.
- 10. BCP provides full range of primary care medical services.
- Home visit service is offered to patients who are too unwell to make it to the practice.
- If you need to go to hospital you will be given a choice of which hospital you wish to go to.
- On the day (with duty doctor) / advance (preferred doctor/nurse) appointments can be requested.
