#### 4. APPOINTMENTS

There was a general discussion about appointments, including the difficulty in making appointments.

The importance of patients' having face-to-face appointments with doctors was emphasised, as well as the requirement to provide review appointments.

The Operations Manager agreed to arrange a report on proposals to recognise the importance of these issues.

#### 5. YOUNG CARERS

#### **CROSSROADS YOUNG CARERS SERVICE IN BREIGHTMET**

This is a service, soon to be set up, which will give groups of young carers a chance to talk to one another about life as a young carer and share experiences.

There will also be one-to-one sessions giving young carers the opportunity to talk about how things are going at home, and also identifying if help may be needed.

#### 6. HORWICH HEALTH AND WELLBEING HUB

Horwich residents have had their say on proposed plans to bring forward the development of a new Health and Wellbeing Hub, with an approximately 170-space car park, next to the New Leisure Centre, on Victoria Road, Horwich.

92% of respondees were in favour of the development.

NHS Bolton, Bolton CCG and Bolton Council sought the views of the Horwich community on the proposal to relocate GP services to a new Hub. The plans would see the relocation of two Horwich GP Practices: Bolton Community Practice and Pikes View Medical Centre, which would join up with Community Services from the Royal Bolton Hospital Foundation Trust to create an opportunity to merge health, wellness, and leisure services to the benefit of residents.

The new Health Centre would provide a range of high-quality clinical services and treatment in a fully dementia friendly and accessible Centre.

The joining of teams and integrated services would give patients seamless care with in-hub referrals to local voluntary and third sector organisations and services including mental health support, health visiting, occupational therapy, midwifery, podiatry and more. The Hub would be home to a primary care team of pharmacists, physicians, nurses and mental health practitioners offering a seven-day extended service in the heart of the community.

The plans could also allow for some services such as MR scanning to be provided at the Hub rather than at the hospital, meaning that patients could be treated locally.

#### 7. LITTLE LEVER HEALTH CENTRE

The Little Lever Health Centre remains closed not withstanding PAG's continuing expressed concern at the lack of publicity.

#### 8. VACCINATION PRORAMME

25,000 people had now been vaccinated.
